

## **The International Cyber-Terrorism Regulation Project (ICTRP) Expert Peer Reviewers**

### **Ms. Sigalit Maor-Hirsh**

Ms. Sigalit Maor-Hirsh is the former head of Cyber sub-division in the Israeli Prime Minister's office. She is an associate at the International Institute for Counter-Terrorism (ICT), IDC, Herzliya and at the Institute for National Security Studies (INSS), Israel. Sigalit is an expert in cyber-intelligence and specializes in terrorism. Within the framework of the IDC, Sigalit researches the reciprocal relations between the new media and contingency politics, in events such as social protests, consciousness campaigns, and terrorism. This includes conducting the development of integrating methods of contingency politics, sociology, social media and platforms, and political changes. Sigalit is a lecturer in the Administration department at the IDC, and teaches the courses "National security in cyber" and "Social networks & political changes". She has an M.A degree in communication and new media from the IDC. In 2016, she graduated from the Israeli senior leadership program at the 'Wexner Foundation' at Harvard Kennedy School.

### **Dr. Kubo Mačák**

Dr. Kubo Mačák is a Senior Lecturer in Law at the University of Exeter (United Kingdom). He holds a DPhil in International Law from the University of Oxford. Kubo has been a visiting researcher at the Max Planck Institute for Comparative Public Law and International Law in Heidelberg (Germany), the University of Haifa (Israel), and Wuhan University (China). He has worked at the United Nations ad hoc tribunals for the former Yugoslavia and Rwanda. He is currently serving as a core expert on the Woomera Manual on the International Law of Military Space Operations project. His research interests span international cyber law, international humanitarian law, and general international law. Most recently, Kubo is the author of Internationalized Armed Conflicts in International Law (OUP 2018).

### **Dr. Nicolas Mazzucchi**

Dr. Nicolas Mazzucchi is a Research Fellow at the "Fondation pour la Recherche Stratégique" (FRS) in Paris. He is in charge of energy, primary goods and cyber issues. He holds a PhD in Economic geography from Université Paris 1 Panthéon-Sorbonne and he spent years at the French Ministry of Defense before joining the FRS in 2018. Dr. Mazzucchi is also lecturer in geopolitics at Sciences Po Paris and for the French MoD superior officers' courses. He is author

of more than 20 scientific papers and of *Energie, ressources, technologies et enjeux de pouvoir* (Armand Colin; 2017) and co-author with F-B Huyghe and O Kempf of *Gagner les cyberconflits* (Economica; 2015). In 2019, he was among the 100 French leaders in cybersecurity in the *Usine Nouvelle* ranking.

### **Adv. Jonathan Alexandron Moshonov**

Adv. Jonathan Alexandron Moshonov has extensive experience in the legal and technical aspects of privacy, regulation technology (RegTech), Fintech and cyber security. Jonathan holds an LL.B from the Hebrew University in Jerusalem, an MBA from Bar-Ilan University and he is a PhD student at the faculty of law at Maastricht University.

### **Dr. David Scharia**

Dr. David Scharia is Chief of Branch at the United Nations Security Council Counter terrorism executive directorate (CTED). Dr. Scharia is in charge of counter terrorism policy and heads a large group of international counter terrorism experts, monitoring States' implementation of counter terrorism measures and advising the Security Council CTC on counter terrorism matters. The Branch under his leadership covers all areas of counter terrorism policy including legal and criminal justice responses, financing of terrorism, law enforcement and border control, gender dimension of counter terrorism, terrorists' use of technologies and the internet, human rights and CVE. Dr. Scharia is an internationally recognized expert on counter terrorism. His articles and books have been published by Oxford University Press, Harvard National Security Journal, and Hebrew University Press. Recently, he was invited to serve as a National Security Scholar-in Residence at Columbia Law School and a Fellow at NYU Center for Global Affairs.

### **Ms. Rhea Siers**

Ms. Rhea Siers is a veteran of over thirty years at the National Security Agency (NSA) where she served in senior operational, policy and legal capacities including Deputy Associate Director for Policy. Ms. Siers is an attorney, cybersecurity consultant and Senior Policy & Legal Fellow at the Institute for Information Infrastructure Protection (I3P) at George Washington University (GWU). She teaches courses at GWU and Johns Hopkins on cybersecurity, terrorism, counterterrorism, and intelligence.
